Early Registration

Don't forget the early registration deadline is approaching! You should have received information on discounts as well as an application in the mail several weeks ago, but here's a quick recap just in case.

The deadline for early registration is December 31st. If you turn in your application by then you can get up to 15% off of your tuition (if you pay in full) or 10% off (if you pay a deposit, with the rest due before May 1, 2013). Additionally, you can receive a \$20 discount per \$1000 of tuition for paying by check or cash. The faster you register, the more likely you are to be guaranteed a spot in the session of your choice.

After a large amount of thought, I have decided that we will not be offering Falcon Horse Lover Camp as a program for 2013. There are many factors involved and I really want to take a summer to decide the best direction for Falcon Camp and our entire horse program. We designed it for girls who had enough riding experience to know they loved horses and wanted to, as the logo says, "eat, sleep and breathe horses". These were mostly girls who rode throughout the year and spent their time at Falcon just absorbing everything possible about horses. In the past 8-10 years there has been a proliferation of so many riding barns that now offer summer day camp programs and encourage their students to stay home and
